

**TANGNEY TOURS BOOKING CONDITIONS**

**PAYMENT**  
Once you have received your confirmation of booking, the balance of payment due must be sent to us two months prior to departure. If a booking is made within two months of departure, full payment must be made on receipt by the party leader of the confirmation invoice. This date is shown on the confirmation invoice. Reminders are not sent. If we do not receive all payments due (including any surcharge where applicable) in full and on time, we are entitled to assume that you wish to cancel your booking. In this case, we will be entitled to keep all deposits paid or due at that date. If we do not cancel straight away because you have promised to make payment, you must pay the cancellation charges shown under "Cancellation By You" below depending on the date we reasonably treat your booking as cancelled.

**SPECIAL REQUESTS AND MEDICAL CONDITIONS / DISABILITIES**  
If you have any special request, you must advise us at the time of booking. Although we will endeavour to pass any reasonable requests on to the relevant supplier, we regret we cannot guarantee any request will be met. Failure to meet any special request will not be a breach of contract on our part.

If you have any medical condition or disability which may affect your tour or have any special requirements as a result of any medical condition or disability (including any which affect the booking process), please tell us before you confirm your booking so that we can assist you in considering the suitability of the arrangements and/or making the booking. In any event, you must give us full details in writing at the time of booking and whenever any change in the condition or disability occurs. You must also promptly advise us if any medical condition or disability which may affect your tour develops after your booking has been confirmed.

**FINANCIAL SECURITY**  
We hold an Air Travel Organiser's Licence issued by the Civil Aviation Authority (ATOL number 1220). When you buy an ATOL protected air inclusive holiday or flights\* from us you will receive a confirmation invoice from us or via our authorised agent confirming your arrangements and your protection under our ATOL. In the unlikely event of our insolvency the CAA will ensure that you are not left stranded abroad and will arrange to refund any money you have paid to us for an advance booking. Please note: Not all holiday or travel services offered and sold by us will be protected by the ATOL scheme.

\*The air inclusive holidays and flights we arrange are ATOL protected providing either the person who pays for the booking is present in the UK when the booking is made or the first leg of any flight(s) we arrange for you commences in the UK.

**CANCELLATION BY YOU**  
A cancellation by you will take effect on the date we receive this in writing. Cancellation of the whole booking requires notification by the party leader. We will apply the following scale of cancellation charges based on the period before departure notice in writing is received and where applicable, is expressed as a percentage of the total tour cost excluding any insurance premiums and amendment charges which are non refundable in the event of cancellation.

**POLICY EXCESSES:**  
**Cancellation or Curtailment**  
The first £50 of each and every claim per Insured Person claimed for under this Section is excluded, increased to £100 where You are aged 66 to 75 years and to £150 where You are aged 76 to 95 years (other than in respect of claims for loss of deposit where the excess is £25).

**Medical and Other Expenses**  
The first £50 of each and every claim per Insured Person claimed for under this Section is excluded. Where You are aged 66 to 75 years the first £100 of each and every claim per Insured Person claimed for under this Section is excluded.

Where You are aged 76 to 95 years the first £200 of each and every claim per Insured Person claimed for under this Section is excluded. No Excess will apply where an EHIC is utilised

**Other Sections**

  - For Terminal Illness, having obtained prior to departure and supplied to Us written confirmation of a prognosis greater than 28 days on the intended date of return to the UK. A limit of £5,000 shall apply in respect of any Repatriation Expenses.
  - The Hospital Benefit section of the policy is inoperative.
  - The Cancellation & Curtailment section is inoperative.
- The Policy Excess applying to the Medical and Other Expenses sections is increased to £1,500 or £500 where an EHIC is utilised

**EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE:**  
There is a 24-hour emergency assistance service included in the policy so that any insured person may seek assistance in medical emergencies whilst on holiday. Full details are contained in the policy document.

**MAIN HEALTH EXCLUSIONS:**

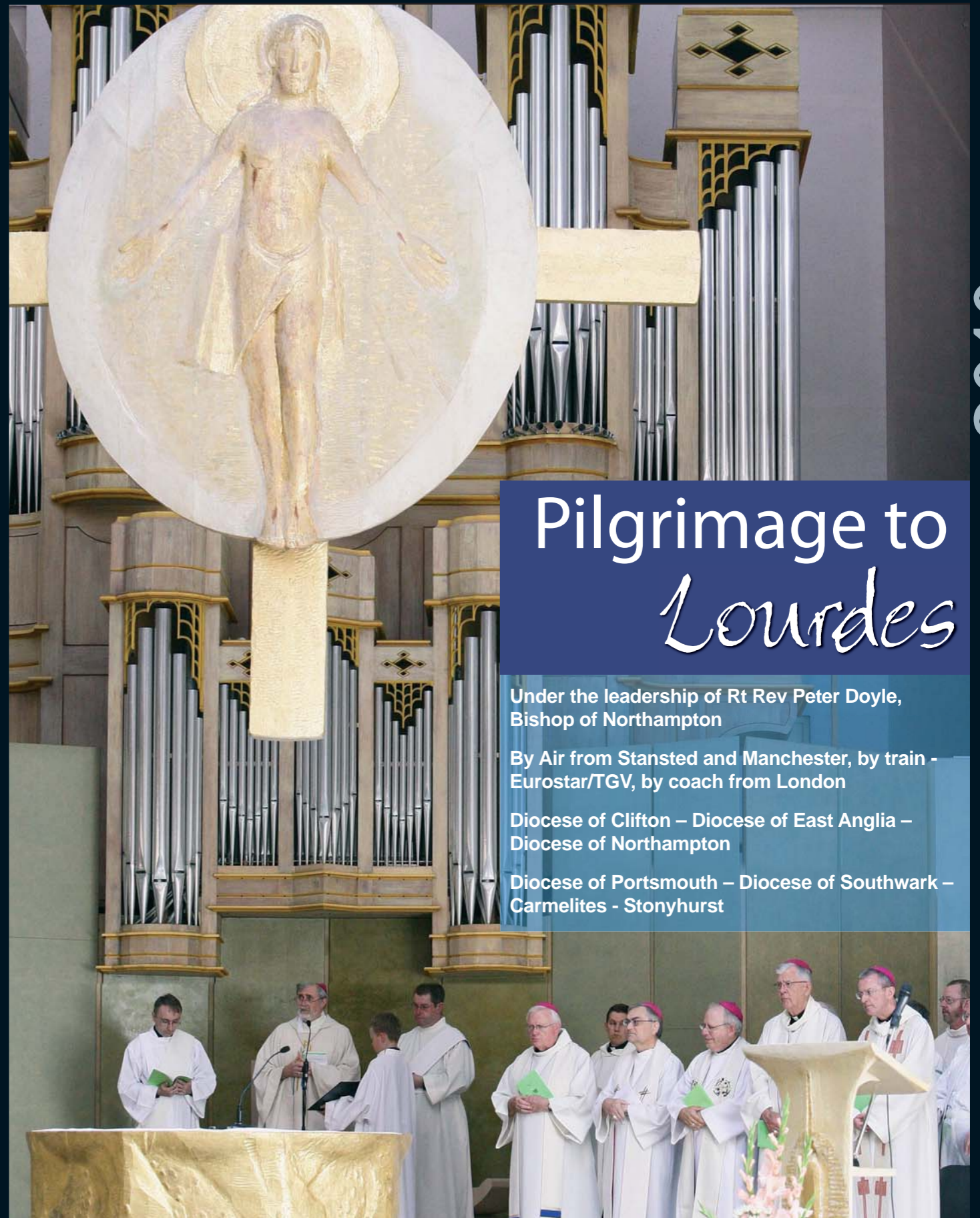
**Applicable Law**

## TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

### Travel by Air

Flights will be available from Stansted and other Airports that will be confirmed depending on requests. All flights will include taxes and transfers from Lourdes Airport to your hotels.

### Travel by Train

By morning Eurostar from St Pancras to Paris Gare du Nord and then continue to Lourdes by train with coach transfer to your hotel arriving for dinner. On the return you will depart mid morning to Paris Gare du Nord, and onwards to London arriving early evening. The train is quite limited in the number of wheelchairs that can be carried, but as always we will have plenty of chairs available in Lourdes. First Class is available on the train however we will not know the supplements until May 2010.

### Travel by Coach

Following demand for a cheaper travel option, a coach section is now offered, departing from London on Friday 20th August in the afternoon travelling overnight to Lourdes for 6 nights full board accommodation and returning on the night of 26/27 August. The coach will be equipped with W.C., DVD player, air conditioning and reclining seats.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

### Hotels and Accueil Notre Dame

All the hotels used offer good value for money, generally the more expensive are nearer the Grotto. All include continental breakfast, lunch and dinner. All hotel rooms are with W.C. bath/shower, and lift to all floors. The Accueil Notre Dame accommodation is for those who are dependent on nursing care. These rooms do not have private facilities but the modern well designed hostel is comfortable and beautifully located within the Sanctuary.

Special menus and diets are available, but must be pre-booked. Vegetarian meals are not well understood by the French and will occasionally disappoint. A few words with the Tangney Tours representative or the hotel may help. Medical diets must be written out and submitted in advance.

Handicapped rooms are available in most hotels and certainly in the Accueil Notre Dame but must be requested in advance with details of any special needs. Special equipment may need to be hired and paid for in advance (apart from the Accueil Notre Dame which is fully equipped).

### Assisted Pilgrims

Assisted Pilgrims are those who have a medical condition which causes them to need assistance with mobility or care during their week in Lourdes. If you require wheelchair assistance you MUST register. In addition the Clergy require all who wish to be to be considered for the sacrament of the Anointing to be registered as an Assisted Pilgrim. Closing date for registration: 15th July 2010.

### Registered Hotel Assisted Pilgrims

- Should be able to look after themselves within a hotel or be accompanied by someone who can help to look after them in the hotel and on the journey.
- If registered are able to receive wheelchair assistance in Lourdes but not necessarily at UK airports
- Should book with Tangney Tours using this form and request a Medical Form from Tangney Tours or their Diocesan Director, to be completed and sent to the Pilgrimage Doctor.

### Registered Accueil Notre Dame Pilgrims

- Are likely to need extra care during the Pilgrimage. They will have careers, served meals and all their mobility needs met whilst in Lourdes as well as supervision from nursing and medical staff in very comfortable accommodation near the Grotto.
- Should not use this form but request a Medical Form from Tangney Tours or their Diocesan Director and on completion send it to the Pilgrimage Doctor. Once accepted they will receive a special booking form. In case of queries please contact: Dr Adam Farmer on 07054 656115

### To Volunteer as a Helper or Musician

To facilitate our Pilgrimage many Helpers are required, particularly to care for those staying in the Accueil. Priests, Deacons, Musicians, Doctors and Nurses have obvious roles. Other Volunteers are required for duties ranging from pushing wheelchairs to serving meals. After booking you will be sent a Helpers' Form and Information Sheet, with details of Preparation Days, at which experienced helpers give advice and information and CRB checks can be completed. If you are able to help us, please complete and return the volunteer form as promptly as possible.

### Passports:

All pilgrims must possess a full 10 year passport. Please allow at least 8 weeks to obtain yours. Forms are obtainable from the Post Office. Please make sure that your passport is valid up to three months after the return date of the Pilgrimage. N.B. Children of all ages including babies cannot now be added to parent's passports. They must have their own. No passport = no go and no



refund. All holders of non EC passports should make their own enquiries with the French Consulate to find out whether a visa for France is necessary.

### Medical Treatment:

Whilst abroad in EC countries medical treatment is covered by a reciprocal agreement with those countries. If you do not yet have a European Health Insurance Card (EHIC), please contact your local Post Office who will give you the necessary forms to compete so that you can have one of these cards, which have replaced the old E111. ### HOTELS

**Beau Site**, an excellent 3 star hotel on the flat, overlooking the river, partly owned by the hotel Méditerranée.

**Notre Dame de France & Irlande**, well established older hotels with most modern amenities. Both are quite close to the Domain.

**Solitude / St Sauveur**, these two hotels are owned by the Vinuales family.

The Solitude is a purpose built hotel situated in a quiet passage, great rooms especially for handicapped people, some with good views. The St Sauveur has smaller rooms but a more personal service. The position of both these hotels dictates the price.

**Padoue**, a brand new hotel with all modern aids for the disabled close to the sanctuary.

**Gallia & Londres**, 4 star regency style hotel near St Joseph's Gate. Very pleasant restaurant and attractive garden. All bedrooms decorated in the style of Louis XVI.
