There is an understanding that diocesan priests who supply within a deanery are not normally paid a fee.

I would suggest that all diocesan priests are paid if they are retired or if they are not supported financially as a parish priest or assistant but live away from parish accommodation and rely on supply work for their income.

TRAVEL EXPENSES

1. To work out mileage go onto the Web and type in The AA Route Guide.
2. This will present a 'From.....' and 'To.....'
3. Enter Post Code of Church going 'To....' and then enter your own Post Code in 'From.....'
4. This will give you single journey mileage.
5. Multiply this by 2
6. And then multiply this at 45 pence per mile to give cost travel expenses
