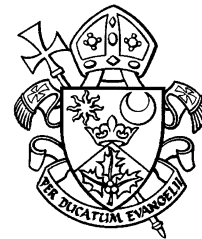




Walk the World

Dear Youth Leader,

Thank you for your interest in Walk the World!

This sponsored walk is being organized by the Department for Pastoral Formation and CAFOD Portsmouth. It is an opportunity for young people (and the not so young!) to take part in raising funds for World Youth Day and the work of CAFOD. Individuals travelling to World Youth Day in Madrid are taking part to help in their fundraising for the trip whilst other groups are being encouraged to raise money for the work of CAFOD.

The route starts and finishes at the Church of the Immaculate Conception in Stubbington and the route is approximately 8 miles along a fairly flat route.

Along the route there will be a number of checkpoints and places where we will ask the walkers to reflect on the work of CAFOD and the Holy Father's words to young people at World Youth Day.

10.00am	Opening Liturgy and blessing of walkers.

12.00pm – 1.00pm	Picnic lunch at St John the Evangelist Church, Lee-on-the-Solent. Please bring a packed lunch.
1.00pm	Set off to return to Stubbington.
3.00pm	Arrival back at Stubbington. Refreshments available
