This sponsored walk is being organized by the Department for Pastoral Formation and CAFOD Portsmouth. It is an opportunity for young people (and the not so young!) to take part in raising funds for World Youth Day and the work of CAFOD.

The route starts and finishes at the Church of the Immaculate Conception in Stubbington and the route is approximately 8 miles along a fairly flat route.
